GENERAL DUTIES

SOME OF THE TASKS AND DUTIES

- 1) Works with heavy-duty power equipment and hand tools in the construction and repair of microwave towers in excess of 200 feet tall, parabolic antennas up to 15 feet in diameter weighing more than 3,000 pounds.
- 2) May be required to climb 100 foot non-stepped poles with the use of climbers.
- 3) Installs and maintains OMNI-directional antennas on wooden poles in excess of 100 feet tall.
- 4) Loads required tools and material into assigned Company vehicle and drives or rides to work locations.
- 5) Rigs loads in excess of 3000 pounds to be hoisted over 200 feet high.
- 6) Operates 8 ton articulated hydraulic crane.
- 7) Understands block loading principles using "parts of line" to determine mechanical advantage.
- 8) Install and maintains waveguide air pressure systems.
- 9) Drive vehicles with three or more axles or tow other vehicles of 10,000 pounds or more. Required to hold a Class "A" Driver's License.
- 10) All employees must hold a commercial vehicle driver's license and, as part of their job function, are required to operate a motor vehicle whose Gross Combination Weight rating of 26,001 or more pounds inclusive of a towed unit with a gross vehicle weight rating of more than 10,000
- lbs. Federal regulations require participation in mandated drug and alcohol

testing programs.

- 11) Receives verbal and/or written work orders and instructions from supervisor or lead technician.
- 12) Reviews and analyzes complex schematic drawings to determine work to be done, methods, and sequence of tasks.
- 13) Performs various types of construction operations which all require heavy physical labor and lifting.
- 14) Required to follow standards and practice while meeting service deadlines.
- 15) Performs housekeeping duties for assigned Company vehicles and various work locations for the safety of the employee and protection of the facilities under construction.
- 16) Performs preventative maintenance on all assigned Company tools, equipment, and motor vehicles.
- 17) Uses hand tools to attach and detach various kinds of hardware to towers, antennas, etc. Works with color-coded waveguides and coaxial cables.
- 18) Must meet specific quality, production, and safety standards.
- 19) Works with tools, equipment, and cable that may be heavy which have to be loaded and unloaded from Company vehicle, moved, or rearranged.
- 20) Performs time reporting tasks on a daily basis.

ENVIRONMENT

- 1) Exposed to various adverse weather conditions, e.g., cold rain, snow, heat, etc.
- 2) Works outside aloft on microwave towers, 100 foot non stepped poles, on ladders, and occasionally on aerial personnel lifts.
- 3) Works with hands in tight areas for extended period of time
- 4) Works on job assignment that exposes technician to above normal level of dirt, oil, grease, dust, mud, and water.
- 5) Complies with hazardous waste restrictions.
- 6) Must wear safety glasses, hard hat, heeled boots, and any other necessary protective gear or clothing.
- 7) 95% of work requires travel away from headquarters location.
- 8) Occasional tours of 11 days on and 3 off are required.
- 9) Requires above average mechanical aptitude to solve structural problems that arise in the field during the construction and maintenance procedures.
